ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant Roy J. Main initiated this action by filing *pro se* an "Application for a Writ of Mandamus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1651." In an order filed on December 11, 2009, Magistrate Judge Boyd N. Boland directed the clerk of the Court to commence a civil action and directed Mr. Main to cure certain deficiencies if he wished to pursue his claims.
