Dear Clerk of Court:

On November 23, 2009, the Honorable Michael J. Davis, Chief United States District Judge for the District Court of Minnesota, entered an *Ex Parte* Statutory Restraining Order in *CFTC v. Cook, et al.*, Civil Case No. 09-cv-3332 (MJD/JJK), whereby R.J. Zayed was appointed as temporary Receiver ("Receiver") for the Defendants and their affiliates and subsidiaries, and all funds, properties, premises, accounts and other assets directly or indirectly owned, beneficially or otherwise, by the Defendants individually or collectively, including, but not limited to, investors' funds, for the purpose of marshalling, preserving, accounting for, and liquidating the assets that are subject to that Order.

Pursuant to 28 USCS § 754, the receiver shall "... file copies of the complaint and such order of appointment [of the receiver] in the district court for each district in which property is located."

Accordingly, enclosed for filing in the District of Colorado are two copies of the above-referenced Order and the Complaint for Injunctive and Other Equitable Relief and for Penalties and Under the Commodity Exchange Act and the CFTC Order in *CFTC v. Cook, et al.*
