ORDER OF DISMISSAL


Plaintiff, Joseph Arbing, is in the custody of the United States Bureau of Prisons and currently is incarcerated at the United States Penitentiary in Florence, Colorado. Mr. Arbing, acting *pro se*, initiated this action by filing a pleading titled "Criminal Complaint," in which he challenges the conditions of his confinement. In an order entered on January 15, 2010, Magistrate Judge Boyd N. Boland directed the Clerk of the Court to commence a civil action and instructed Mr. Arbing to cure certain deficiencies if he wished to pursue his claims. Specifically, Magistrate Judge Boland ordered Mr. Arbing to file his claims on a Court-approved form that is used in filing prisoner complaints. Magistrate Judge Boland also directed Mr. Arbing either to pay the filing fee in full or to file a motion seeking leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 along with a certified copy of his trust fund statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the initiation of this action.

Magistrate Judge Boland warned Mr. Arbing that the action would be dismissed without further notice if he failed to cure the deficiencies within thirty days. Mr. Arbing has failed to communicate with the Court. As a result, he has failed to cure the deficiencies within the time allowed. Therefore, the action will be dismissed without prejudice for failure to cure the noted deficiencies. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Complaint and action are dismissed without prejudice for failure to cure the deficiencies.


