ORDER OF DISMISSAL

ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KRISTEN L. MIX

This matter is before the Court on the parties' **Stipulated Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice** [#138]¹ (the "Motion"). In the Motion the parties state that they "have agreed to a settlement of the claims brought by Plaintiff Tuckel." *Motion* [#138] at 1. After reviewing the Motion and the entire record, the Court finds that the Motion [#138] should be **granted** and this action should be **dismissed with prejudice**. Accordingly,

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that Plaintiff's motion titled "Production of Documents" [#136] is **DENIED**.
