**ORDER ADOPTING AND AFFIRMING SEPTEMBER 9, 2011
RECOMMENDATION OF UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE**

This case was referred to United States Magistrate Judge Michael E. Hegarty pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636. On September 9, 2011, the Magistrate Judge issued a Recommendation (Doc. # 106), recommending that Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction and for Protective Order (Doc. # 99) be denied. 
