**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND
 DIRECTING MOVANT TO CURE DEFICIENCY**

Movant has submitted a letter to the court, a "Motion to Appoint Counsel / Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis Pursuant 28 USC § 1915 for State Habeas Corpus 28 USC § 2254" and a "Motion for 'Stay and Abeyance' of State Habeas Corpus 28 USC § 2254 Action / Pending Resolution of 'Motion to Appoint Counsel.'" As part of the court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.2, the court has determined that the submitted documents are deficient as described in this order. Notwithstanding the deficiencies, the clerk of the court will be directed to commence a civil action. Movant will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue his claims. Any papers which the Movant files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.

28 U.S.C. § 1915 Motion and Affidavit:

- (1) is not submitted
- (2) is missing affidavit
- (3) is missing certified copy of prisoner's trust fund statement for the 6-month period immediately preceding this filing
- (4) is missing certificate showing current balance in prison account
- (5) is missing required financial information
- (6) is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (7) is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (8) names in caption do not match names in caption of complaint, petition or habeas application
- (9) An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.
- (10) other: Motion is necessary only if filing fee is not paid in advance.

Complaint, Petition or Application:

- (11) is not submitted
- (12) is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (13) is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (14) is missing page nos.
- (15) uses et al. instead of listing all parties in caption
- (16) An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.
- (17) Sufficient copies to serve each defendant/respondent have not been received by the court.
- (18) names in caption do not match names in text
- (19) other _____

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the clerk of the court commence a civil action in this matter. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Movant cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.** Any papers which the Movant files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court mail to the Movant, together with a copy of this order, two copies of the following forms: Prisoner's Motion and

Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 in a Habeas Corpus Action and Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that, if the Movant fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order**, the action will be dismissed without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice.
