## ORDER ADOPTING RECOMMENDATION OF THE UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE

## Blackburn, J.

This matter is matter before me on the following: (1) Motion of Defendants US

Bank National Association as Trustee for BS ALTA 2006-3 and GMAC Bank To

Dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint for Failure to Effect Service of Process [#26]¹ filed

August 18, 2010; and (2) the magistrate judge's Recommendation on Defendants'

Motion To Dismiss [#29] filed September 29, 2010. No objections to the

recommendation have been filed and, therefore, I review it only for plain error. See

Morales-Fernandez v. Immigration & Naturalization Service, 418 F.3d 1116, 1122

(10th Cir. 2005).² Finding no error, much less plain error, in the magistrate judge's recommended disposition, I find and conclude that the recommendation should be

approved and adopted.

The plaintiffs are proceeding *pro se* in this case. It took the plaintiffs some time

to determine how properly to serve a summons and the complaint on the defendants.

As detailed by the magistrate judge, however, the plaintiffs have demonstrated good-

faith and repeated efforts to effect proper service on the defendants. Given the

circumstances described by the magistrate judge in his recommendation, I agree with

his recommendation that the motion to dismiss be denied.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the magistrate judge's Recommendation on Defendants' Motion To

Dismiss [#29] filed September 29, 2010, is APPROVED AND ADOPTED as an order

of this court; and

2. That the Motion of Defendants US Bank National Association as Trustee

for BS ALTA 2006-3 and GMAC Bank To Dismiss Plaintiffs' Complaint for Failure

to Effect Service of Process [#26] filed August 18, 2010, is DENIED.
