ORDER

This matter is before the Court on plaintiffs' motion for partial summary judgment [Docket No. 34]. In their motion, plaintiffs state that their "arguments in favor of entry of partial summary judgment are set forth in the simultaneously filed Plaintiffs' Brief in Support of Motion for Partial Summary Judgment." Docket No. 34 at 1. On December 20, 2010, the Court struck plaintiffs' brief, however, for failure to comply with § III.F.3.b.ii of this Court's Practice Standards.
