**ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO COMMENCE CIVIL ACTION AND  
DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCY**

Plaintiff, Charlotte Maddox, has submitted a Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and a Complaint. She has not provided a mailing address to the court, and in the Complaint, she states that she is a homeless person currently living in downtown Denver, Colorado. As part of the court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.1, the court has determined that the submitted document are deficient as described in this order. Notwithstanding the deficiencies, the clerk of the court will be directed to commence a civil action. Plaintiff will be directed to cure the following if she wishes to pursue her claims. Any papers which the Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order.

**Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915:**

- (1)  is not submitted
- (2)  is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (3)  is missing original signature by Plaintiff
- (4)  is missing affidavit
- (5)  affidavit is incomplete

- (8)  An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.

**Complaint or Petition:**

- (10)  is not submitted
- (11)  is not on proper form (must use the court's current form)
- (12)  is missing an original signature by the Plaintiff

- (16)  Sufficient copies to serve each defendant/respondent have not been received by the court.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the clerk of the court commence a civil action in this matter. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.** Any papers which the Plaintiff files in response to this order must include the civil action number on this order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court mail to the Plaintiff together with a copy of this order, copies of the following forms: Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 and Complaint. Because Plaintiff has not provided a mailing address, the clerk of the court is directed to send Plaintiff's mail to:

FURTHER ORDERED that, if the Plaintiff fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order**, the complaint and the action will be dismissed without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice.
