ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Status Conference is set in this matter for Monday, **August 23, 2010, at 9:00 a.m.** in Courtroom 203 on the second floor of the Byron G. Rogers United States Courthouse, 1929 Stout Street, Denver, Colorado.¹ If this date is not convenient, counsel

should confer with opposing counsel and contact Chambers at (303) 844-4507 to inquire about alternate available dates. Absent exceptional circumstances, no request for rescheduling will be entertained unless made **five business days prior** to the date of the conference.

Lawyers whose offices are located outside of the Denver metropolitan area may appear at the Status Conference by telephone. Please contact Chambers at (303) 844-4507 to arrange appearance by telephone.

The parties are further advised that they shall not assume that the Court will grant the relief requested in any motion. Failure to appear at a Court-ordered conference or to comply with a Court-ordered deadline which has not be vacated by Court order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
