MINUTE ORDER

ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KRISTEN L. MIX

This matter is before the Court on the parties' **Stipulated Motion to Vacate Final Pretrial Conference** [Docket No. 32; Filed May 19, 2011] (the "Motion").

IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED in part**.

The parties request that a final pretrial conference be rescheduled after the Court has ruled on the pending Motions to Dismiss [Docket Nos. 22 & 23] and Motion to Strike [Docket No. 24]. To ensure efficient progress in this case, the Court prefers to reschedule case management deadlines and conferences rather than postpone them indefinitely. Accordingly,

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the Final Pretrial Conference set for June 15, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. is **vacated** and **RESET** to **September 19, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.** in Courtroom **C-204** of the Byron G. Rogers United States Courthouse.

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the parties shall submit their proposed pretrial order **no later than September 14, 2011**. Parties participating in ECF shall submit their proposed pretrial order pursuant to the District of Colorado ECF Procedures. The proposed pretrial order must be submitted in a useable format (i.e., as a WordPerfect document). Pursuant to the ECF Procedures, the parties shall submit the proposed pretrial order via email to Mix\_Chambers@cod.uscourts.gov. Parties not participating in ECF shall submit their proposed pretrial order to the Clerk of the Court as a hard copy. However, if *any* party in this case is participating in ECF, it is the responsibility of that party to submit the

proposed pretrial order pursuant to the ECF Procedures. **The parties shall prepare the proposed pretrial order in accordance with the form which may be downloaded in richtext format from the forms section of the Court's website at [www.co.uscourts.gov](http://www.co.uscourts.gov). Instructions for downloading in richtext format are posted in the forms section of the website.**
