P. 12(b)(6)" ("Surreply") (filed October 14, 2010) (doc. # 20). Currently pending before the court in this civil action is "Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6)" (doc. # 12). Pursuant to the Order of Reference dated July 22, 2010 (doc. # 2) and the memorandum dated September 28, 2010 (doc. # 15), the Motion has been referred to the Magistrate Judge. Mr. Marotta filed his Response to the Motion on September 29, 2010. (See doc. # 17). Defendants filed their Reply to the Motion on October 11, 2010. (See doc. # 19).
