MINUTE ORDER

Entered by Michael E. Hegarty, United States Magistrate Judge, on April 5, 2012.

Before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion Concerning Matters for Consideration [filed April 4, 2012; docket #175]. The motion asks the Court to strike Defendant's motion for summary judgment because Plaintiff asserts it was filed past the deadline for dispositive motions.
