The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal of Defendant Robert Beaumont** [#82]¹ filed February 11, 2013. 1. That the **Stipulation of Dismissal of Defendant Robert Beaumont** [#82] filed February 11, 2013, is **APPROVED**;


2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant Mr. Robert Beaumont are **DISMISSED** with each of the affected parties to pay its own attorney fees and costs;
