This matter is before the Court on plaintiff's Motion to Stay Ruling on Summary Judgment Until Completion of Depositions of Disorbio and Bruns [Docket No. 18], which is actually a motion for extension of time to respond to defendant's motion for summary judgment [Docket No. 17].
