**ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION OF AWARD OF ATTORNEY FEES
UNDER THE EQUAL ACCESS TO JUSTICE ACT**

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Motion For Order Approving Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access To Justice Act** [#22]¹ filed May 31, 2012. After reviewing the motion and the file, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that plaintiff should be awarded attorney fees in the amount of four thousand two hundred dollars (\$4,200.00) under the Equal Access To Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That the **Motion For Order Approving Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access To Justice Act** [#22] filed May 31, 2012, is **GRANTED**; and

2. That plaintiff is awarded attorney fees in the amount of four thousand two hundred dollars (\$4,200.00) under the Equal Access To Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).
