ORDER DIRECTING PAYMENT FOR FREE TRANSCRIPT



Pursuant to Rule 24(a)(3) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, Plaintiff is authorized to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 753(f), the court certifies that this appeal is not frivolous and presents a substantial question, *i.e.*, a significant issue that is unique, unusual or reasonably debatable.
