This matter is before the Court on defendant Board of County Commissioners of Garfield County's Motion to Dismiss [Docket No. 9]. On June 15, 2011, plaintiff filed a First Amended Complaint [Docket No. 21] pursuant to the Minute Order [Docket No. 20] granting plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to File an Amended Complaint [Docket No. 18]. Thus, the First Amended Complaint became the operative pleading in this action, and the Motion to Dismiss [Docket No. 9] is directed to an inoperative, superseded pleading. *See, e.g., Gilles v. ORDERED that defendant Board of County Commissioners of Garfield County's Motion to Dismiss [Docket No. 9] is DENIED as moot.
