ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the Status Report [Docket No. 192] filed by plaintiff James C. Franks. On March 1, 2013, the Court issued an Order extending the administrative closure of this case [Docket No. 188] and informed the parties that, in the absence of a request to reopen the case or to extend the administrative closure upon a showing of good cause, this matter would be dismissed without further notice on September 1, 2013.
