This matter arises on **Plaintiff's First Motion to Compel** [Doc. # 34, filed 10/29/2011] (the "Motion to Compel"). In addition, two oral motions were raised at the hearing on November 9, 2011. (4) The depositions noticed by the plaintiffs shall occur at a date and time as the parties may agree during the week of **November 14, 2011**.
