ORDER

This matter arises on the plaintiff's **Motion for Summary Judgment** [Doc. #38] (the "Motion"). The Motion is STRICKEN.

When an enlargement of time is sought after expiration of a specified deadline, the movant must show that the failure to act was the result of excusable neglect. Fed. R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1)(B). The plaintiff does not acknowledge that the deadline has expired, nor does she establish excusable neglect.

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion [Doc. # 38] is STRICKEN.
