## ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF HYBRID FINANCE LTD.'S MOTION TO AMEND CAPTION OF COMPLAINT

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is **Plaintiff Hybrid Finance Ltd.'s Motion To Amend Caption of Complaint** [#34]<sup>1</sup> filed July 5, 2012. Plaintiff seeks to correct the case caption by amendment to show its true place of incorporation. I grant the motion.

In the original caption, plaintiff apparently was misidentified as being a British Virgin Islands corporation, which, in fact, is only "the locale of one of [its] ownership entities[.]" (**Motion** at 2.) In fact, it is an Israeli company. Having thus been advised of the premises, I find and conclude that the motion should be granted and the caption amended to reflect plaintiff's actual place of incorporation. **See Hernandez-Avila v.**

**Averill**, 725 F.2d 25, 28 (2<sup>nd</sup> Cir. 1984) ("[C]ourts generally will allow an amendment under Rule 15 to correct technical defects in the caption.") (quoting 5 C. Wright & A. Miller, **Federal Practice & Procedure** § 1321 at 461 (1969)) (internal quotation marks omitted).

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- That Plaintiff Hybrid Finance Ltd.'s Motion To Amend Caption of Complaint [#34] filed July 5, 2012, is GRANTED; and
- 2. That the caption of this case is **AMENDED** to reflect that plaintiff Hybrid Finance, Limited, is an Israeli company.
