- (1) **Defendants Street Eats Limited, Best Vendors Management, Inc., and Home Depot, U.S.A., Inc.’s Motion to Stay Discovery** [Doc. # 41, filed 9/15/2011] (the “Motion to Stay”);
- (2) **Plaintiffs Motion for Leave of Court to File an Amended Complaint and Jury Demand Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. Rule 15** [Doc. # 43, filed 9/16/2011] (the “Motion to Amend”); and

- (3) The Motion to Withdraw [Doc. # 53] is GRANTED, and Christopher B. Little, Christopher A. Taravella, and Michael R. McCormick of the law firm of Montgomery, Little & Soran, P.C., are relieved of any continuing responsibility in this case.
