**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO

The matter is before me on the **Plaintiff's Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Does 2 and 4 Only** [#27]¹ filed December 19, 2011.

After reviewing the notice and the file, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendants, John Doe 2 and John Doe 4, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That the **Plaintiff's Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Does 2 and 4 Only** [#27] filed December 19, 2011, is **APPROVED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendants, John Doe 2 and John Doe 4, are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**; and
