**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice** [#42]<sup>1</sup> filed November 7, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.

3. That the jury trial set to commence December 1, 2014, is **VACATED**; and


