ORDER OF DISMISSAL


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

3. That the jury trial set to commence October 29, 2012, is **VACATED**; and
4. That this action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
