**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Partial Dismissal of Defendant Mas Torito With Prejudice** [#24]¹ filed February 10, 2012. After reviewing the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendant, Mas Torito, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation of Partial Dismissal of Defendant Mas Torito With Prejudice** [#24] filed February 10, 2012, is **APPROVED**;


2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant Mas Torito are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with each of the affected parties to pay its own attorney fees and costs;
