The matter before me is plaintiff's **Motion To Stay Summary Judgment Briefing Deadlines** [#23],¹ filed November 20, 2012. Plaintiff seeks to stay the deadline for his response to defendant's **Motion for Summary Judgment** [#20], filed November 16, 2012, in light of his request for leave to amend his complaint to add additional facts and claims to this lawsuit. (**See Motion for Leave To Amend the Complaint** [#21], filed November 6, 2012.) The magistrate judge denied that motion. (**See Order on Plaintiff's Motion for Leave To Amend the Complaint (Docket No. 21)** [#30], filed November 29, 2012.) The motion to stay therefore is moot, and I deny it on that basis.²


