The following matters are before the court for consideration: (1) plaintiff's **Motion To Withdraw Action** [#66]² filed November 19, 2012 and (2) plaintiff's **Motion For Leave To Reinstate Case and More** [#67] filed November 21, 2012. After reviewing the motions and the record, the court has concluded that both motions should be denied as moot.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:
