ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation For Dismissal** [#52]¹ filed June 19, 2013. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and this action be dismissed with prejudice, with each party to bear her or its own attorney fees and costs.

3. That the jury trial set to commence July 15, 2013, is **VACATED;**
4. That any pending motion is **DENIED** as moot; and
