THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:



2. That the Final Pretrial Conference and Trial Preparation Conference set for March 29, 2013, are **VACATED**;

3. That the jury trial set to commence April 15, 2013, is **VACATED**;
4. That any pending motion is **DENIED** as moot; and
5. That this action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
