MINUTE ORDER¹

The matter is before the court on **Fidelity's Unopposed Motion To Substitute Its Motion Exclude [sic] Expert Testimony of Erin Toll Under Fed. R. Evid. 702 [#182]**² filed February 24, 2015. After careful review of the motion and the file, the court concludes that the motion should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That **Fidelity's Unopposed Motion To Substitute Its Motion Exclude [sic] Expert Testimony of Erin Toll Under Fed. R. Evid. 702 [#182]** filed February 24, 2015, is granted; and
