The matter is before me on the **Plaintiff's** [*sic*] **Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendant, Khalid Boussetta Only** [#10]¹ filed May 9, 2012. After reviewing the notice and the file, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiffs' claims against defendant Khalid Boussetta should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That **Plaintiff's** [*sic*] **Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendant, Khalid Boussetta Only** [#10] filed May 9, 2012, is

2. That plaintiffs' claims against defendant Khalid Boussetta are **DISMISSED**
