**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**Blackburn, J.**

The matter is before me on the **Plaintiff's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice of All Remaining John Does** [#21]<sup>1</sup> filed August 3, 2012. After reviewing the notice and the record, I conclude that the notice should be approved, that plaintiff's claims against the remaining John Does should be dismissed without prejudice, and that this action should be closed.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Plaintiff's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice of All Remaining John Does** [#21] filed August 3, 2012, is **APPROVED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against all the remaining John Does are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**; and
