THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That the **Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice** [#22] filed December 28, 2012, is **APPROVED**;

3. That the jury trial set to commence August 5, 2013, is **VACATED**;

4. That any pending motion is **DENIED** as moot; and
5. That this action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
