## MINUTE ORDER

## ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KRISTEN L. MIX

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's opposed Motion to Hold in Abeyance Defendant's Motion to Dismiss (Doc. 17) [Docket No. 38; Filed September 20, 2012] (the "Motion"). Plaintiff initiated this case pro se on May 21, 2012. Defendants filed a Motion to Dismiss [\#17] on July 9, 2012, which was subsequently referred to the undersigned [\#18]. The Court issued a Minute Order [\#19] requiring Plaintiff and Defendants to file a Response and a Reply, respectively, addressing only the exhaustion-of-administrativeremedies argument. Plaintiff filed a Response on July 23, 2012 [\#24], and Defendants filed a Reply on August 8, 2012 [\#30]. On September 7, 2012, counsel entered an appearance on behalf of Plaintiff [\#32]. Because Plaintiff is now represented, and because Plaintiff plans on filing an Amended Complaint, Plaintiff asks the Court to temporarily hold in abeyance the pending Motion to Dismiss [\#17].

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion [\#38] is GRANTED. The Court shall hold in abeyance the Motion to Dismiss [\#17] through and including October 25, 2012.
