## MINUTE ORDER

This matter is before the Court on defendant's Motion to Dismiss [Docket No. 12]. On July 31, 2012, plaintiff filed an Amended Complaint [Docket No. 18] pursuant to the Minute Order [Docket No. 17] granting plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Amend[ed] Complaint [Docket No. 14]. Thus, the Amended Complaint became the operative pleading in this action, and the Motion to Dismiss [Docket No. 12] is directed to an inoperative, superseded pleading. *See, e.g., Gilles v.
