ORDER

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Joint Stipulation and Motion To Dismiss** [#58]¹ filed July 10, 2013. After reviewing the motion and the record, I conclude that the

motion should be granted and that the counterclaims of the plaintiff, United States

Department of the Treasury - Internal Revenue Service's against counterclaim

defendant, Marguerite E. Bain, should be dismissed, and that the United States should
be dismissed from this lawsuit with prejudice, under FED. R. CIV. P. 21 and 41(a)(2),
with each party to bear it's own costs and fees.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That **Joint Stipulation and Motion To Dismiss** [#58] filed July 10, 2013, is **GRANTED**:
- 2. That by July 30, 2013, Marguerite E. Bain **SHALL COMPENSATE** the United States via check made payable to the "United States Treasury" in the amount of \$125,000.00, referencing Case No. 12-cv-02111-REB-KLM and mailed to

- 4. That the United States is **DROPPED** as a named party to this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
