The matter before me is the **Stipulation To Dismiss Vining Defendants** [#49]<sup>1</sup> filed April 16, 2013. After reviewing the notice and the record I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendants Daniel L. Vining and Shirley A. Vining should be dismissed with prejudice.
