ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The matter is before the court on plaintiff's **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#5]¹ filed October 2, 2012. In the stipulation [#5], the plaintiff reports that this case has been settled and he requests that this case be dismissed with prejudice. In support of the stipulation, the plaintiff cites FED. R. CIV. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), which permits a plaintiff to dismiss a case without approval of the court by filing a "stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared." The plaintiff is the only party who has appeared in this case.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That plaintiff's **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#5] filed October 2, 2012, is **APPROVED**; and
