ORDER

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is the **Stipulated Motion To Voluntarily Dismiss the City of Lakewood and Amend The Case Caption** [#15]¹ filed October 26, 2012. After reviewing the motion and the record, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that plaintiff's claims defendant Ryan O'Hayre, in his official capacity, should be dismissed without prejudice.

- 4. That Defendant Ryan O'Hayre's Partial Motion To Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint (ECF No. 1) Pursuant to FED. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) [#13] filed October 9, 2012, is DENIED as moot.
