ORDER OF DISMISSAL

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That the **Stipulated Motion To Dismiss Due To Settlement** [#36] filed May 16, 2013, is **GRANTED**;

3. That the trial by jury set to commence October 28, 2013, is **VACATED**; and
