ORDER DISMISSING A PARTY

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#204]¹ filed July 27, 2015. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and the plaintiff's claims against defendant, Dr. Neece, should be dismissed with prejudice.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#204] is approved;

3. That defendant, Dr. Neece, is dropped as a party to this action and the caption shall be amended accordingly.
