FURTHER ORDERED that the motion titled "Motion: Leave to Proceed a Civil Action § 1983 Complaint Against Multiple Dept. of Corrections Facilitys [sic] in One Civil Action Complaint" (ECF No. 1) is denied as unnecessary.
