**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

**Blackburn, J.**

This matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal of Case With Prejudice** [#53],<sup>1</sup> filed January 20, 2015. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
