The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal of Flor Ramirez With Prejudice** [#39]<sup>1</sup> February 25, 2013. After reviewing the notice and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendant Flor Ramirez should be dismissed with prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation of Dismissal of Flor Ramirez With Prejudice** [#39] filed February 25, 2013, is **APPROVED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant Flor Ramirez are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with each of the affected parties to pay its own attorney fees and costs;


