ORDER DISMISSING JOHN DOES 1, 2 & 4, ONLY

The matter before me is **Plaintiff's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice of John Does 1, 2, & 4** [#177]¹ filed January 4, 2013. After reviewing the notice and the record, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against John Does 1, 2, and 4 should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That **Plaintiff's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice of John Does 1, 2, & 4** [#177] filed February 28, 2013, is **APPROVED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against John Does 1, 2 and 4 are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**; and

3. That defendant John Does 1, 2, and 4 are **DROPPED** as named parties to this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
