## ORDER DISMISSING JOHN DOES 9 AND 17, ONLY

## Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is **Plaintiff's Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of John Doe 9 and John Doe 17 Only** [#41]<sup>1</sup> filed

November 13, 2012. After reviewing the notice and the record, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against John Does 9 and 17 should be dismissed with prejudice.

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That Plaintiff's Notice of Settlement and Voluntary Dismissal With Prejudice of John Doe 9 and John Doe 17 Only [#41] is APPROVED;
- 2. That plaintiff's claims against John Does 9 and 17 are **DISMISSED WITH**PREJUDICE; and
