ORDER

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for an Award of

Attorney Fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406(b), filed on September 25, 2014. (Doc. 25).

The Unopposed Motion is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff's counsel is awarded an attorney's fee in the

amount of \$9,433 pursuant to 40 2U.S.C.\( \) 406(b). The fee shall be forwarded and made payable

directly to Plaintiff's attorney, subject to EAJA's offset provisions as set forth below. See 28 U.S.C.

§ 2412(c)(1) (2006); Manning v. Astrue, 510 F.3d 1246, 1251-52 (10th Cir. 2007) ("Under § 406(b),

the Commissioner must withhold and pay a reasonable attorney's fee directly to the attorney out of the

claimant's past-due benefits, thus guaranteeing payment to the attorney and avoiding collection

problems, but the amount of the attorney's fee that must be withheld and directly paid for the attorney

is limited to a maximum of 25% of past-due benefits.").

Upon receipt of the § 406(b) fee, Plaintiff's counsel shall refund to the Plaintiff the previously

paid fee pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA) in the amount of \$6,500.
