ORDER OVERRULING PLAINTIFF'S OBJECTION TO MAGISTRATE JUDGE TAFOYA'S July 7, 2015 ORDER

The matter before me is the **Plaintiff's Objection to Magistrate Judge**

Tafoya's July 7, 2015 Order [#58],¹ filed July 17, 2015. I overrule the objection.
